

Textbook Public Queries

Overview

This document lists public queries that staff can run to view the textbook data entered for classes. For users with the SR Textbook Maintainer role, textbook reports are also available in M-Pathways via the Textbook Reporting page. Textbook information is not available in the UM Data Warehouse.

M-Pathways Public Queries

A public query is a method of directly retrieving data from M-Pathways for purposes of review. The queried data is viewed on a grid in M-Pathways, and can be downloaded into an Excel spreadsheet. The [Run an Existing \(Public\) Query Using Query Viewer](#) step-by-step procedure, available on My LINC, can be used as a guide for running any public query.
